Wallace Endorsed by IUPAT District Council #4

BUFFALO, NY- Assembly Candidate Monica Wallace has received the endorsement of the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT) District Council #4 in her bid for State Assembly in the 143rd District. IUPAT District Council #4 represents roughly 2000 painters, glassworkers, glaziers, and other trades in Western and Central New York.

Wallace is running for the Assembly seat currently held by Conservative Angela Wozniak, who is not seeking reelection. Wallace is a respected attorney, a faculty member at UB Law School, and a former federal law clerk.

The endorsement from IUPAT District Council #4 joins prior endorsements from the Democratic Party, the Working Families party, the Women's Equality party, the Stonewall Democrats, NYSUT, the Police Benevolent Association, Ironworkers Local 6, the Women's TAP fund, and IBEW Local 97. Wallace has also received the support of notable public figures, including former Assembly Majority Leader Paul Tokasz, who represented the 143<sup>rd</sup> for almost two decades.

The 143<sup>d</sup> District includes the Towns of Cheektowaga and Lancaster, as well as the Villages of Depew, Sloan, and Lancaster.
